

Academic calendar starting with DO Week

Please note that a new academic calendar has been introduced from the Spring Semester 2024. Under the new academic calendar, you will have 13 in-person classes and two on-demand video sessions for a total of 15 sessions. During the first week of the semester (called “Doshisha Opening Week” or “DO Week”), you are expected to access the on-demand video URLs from each syllabus and work on the assignments as instructed in the video.

In ILA courses, the second on-demand session is held between Weeks 3 and 13. You will have the opportunity to view the second on-demand session in addition to attending the in-person lecture, effectively participating in two lectures during one of those weeks. Please carefully check the second on-demand session’s week in each course’s syllabus. The semester ends in Week 14.
