

Advanced Registration Information for the Seminars Classes

for Fall Semester 2026

【Note】

Due to unforeseen circumstances, Professor McGuire's seminars will be conducted by Professor Yao SUN in Fall Semester 2026.

The Introductory Seminar

- **Allocation Criteria:** Students will be allocated to seminars based on the following criteria:
 1. Students who have been enrolled for a greater number of semesters will receive priority.
 2. Seminar choice ranking.

【How to apply】

- **Application method:** DUET
- **Application period:** September 15 (Tue) 10 a.m. to September 16 (Wed) 1 p.m.
- **Announcement of Results:** Log in to DUET after 10 a.m. on September 18 (Fri)

【Important】

There will be no additional registration period. If you do not submit your preference during the designated period, you cannot register for Introductory Seminar in the Fall Semester 2026. No exceptions are allowed.

The Intermediate Seminar

- **Capacity:** Each Intermediate Seminar has a maximum enrollment of 14 students.
- **Allocation Criteria:** Students will be allocated to seminars based on the following criteria:
 1. Successful completion of the Introductory Seminar designated with the same letter (A, B, C, D, or E). Students may also enroll in the Intermediate Seminar if they are concurrently taking the Introductory Seminar designated with the same letter during the same semester.
 2. Seminar choice ranking.
 3. GPA at the beginning of the semester in which the seminar will be taken.

【Important】

All students in their fourth and fifth semesters or students in their 6th semester or above who have not completed two Intermediate Seminars are required to indicate their preferences.

Please be aware that semesters are counted from your entry semester, regardless of any leave of absence, military service, or study abroad experiences. The above Forms document also includes an option to indicate if you do not wish to take the Intermediate Seminar.

Please note that students who do not submit this form by the deadline will be randomly assigned to available seminars. You cannot delete or withdraw from the seminar course once assigned.

The Advanced Seminar

For Students entering their First Semester of the Advanced Seminar:

- **Capacity:** Each first-semester Advanced Seminar has a maximum enrollment of 7 students.
- **Allocation Criteria:** Students will be allocated to seminars based on the following criteria:
 1. Successful completion of the Intermediate Seminar that corresponds with the Advanced Seminar*. Students may also enroll if they are concurrently taking the Intermediate Seminar that corresponds with the Advanced Seminar.
 2. Seminar choice ranking.
 3. GPA at the beginning of the semester in which the seminar will be taken.

* Intermediate Seminar A corresponds to Advanced Seminar I-① and 2-①, Intermediate Seminar B corresponds to Advanced Seminar I-② and 2-②, Intermediate Seminar C corresponds to Advanced Seminar I-③ and 2-③, Intermediate Seminar D corresponds to Advanced Seminar I-④ and 2-④, Intermediate Seminar E corresponds to Advanced Seminar I-⑤ and 2-⑤. 【Special Measure for Fall Semester 2026】

Students who have not completed “Intermediate Seminar A” can include “Advanced Seminar 2-①(Prof. Poole’s class)” in their seminar class preference if they have successfully completed “Intermediate Seminar B” in the past semesters.

Students in their sixth semester or above who have not completed the first semester of the Advanced Seminar are required to indicate their preferences.
