2. Join the interview and receive the lecturer's signature on "Registration Approval for Graduate Courses Requiring an Interview".

3. Submit the approval form to the ILA Office via email or in-person by the registration deadline.

4. Complete your course registration by submitting the MS Forms by the deadline.
