In the fall semester, Advanced Registration is available only for the courses that have not reached full capacity. You can see how many seats are left in the course and apply (if there are) on DUET. If the number of applied students exceeds capacity of the class, there will be a random draw.

Please note that you are required to take Japanese language placement test to take Japanese language and culture subjects. Students who took the placement test will be notified of thier Japanese level to Doshisha email account and must register courses at the designated level determined by the test.
