[Guidelines for accepted students]

- 1. You cannot register for seminars.
- 2. You will not receive academic advising on your graduation thesis.
- 3. You may not be allowed to register for some courses.
- 4. If the number of students who wish to take the course exceeds the limit, the registrants will be selected by lot.
- 5. If you would like to have registration advising in advance, you need to contact the office of School of International Liberal Studies for an individual appointment.
- 6. For course registration outside of School of International Liberal Studies, refer to the registration requirement by each relevant faculty or center.

[Other requirements and conditions]

- 7. You must be in the second year or above as of the first day of each semester.
- 8. You must have a TOEFL score of 550 or higher (iBT 79 or higher), the score should be less than two years old at the time of application. However, applicants from The Institute for the Liberal Arts do not need to submit English scores.
- 9. You may apply either for one year or for one semester (spring or fall semester).
